

#### An update from your Church Council:

Happy 2024! Most of our messages to you in 2023 conveyed our goal to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church - your Church, Oak Grove Methodist-Charlotte, has completed disaffiliation processes, by which, as an individual Methodist Church, separated from the domination while keeping property and assets!

We held a unanimous vote on Sunday, February 11, 2024, to accept by-laws that remain in line with the Book of Discipline originally published in 1784 and and has been published every four years since. We have legal assistance also to navigate us through the process.

Nearly six dozen congregations in the Piedmont Triad have agreed to pay more than \$3.7 million - some Churches more than \$200,000 each - for the right to take their more conservative doctrines and the deeds to the properties they have owned for generations and leave the United Methodist Church. Through prayer, we put Oak Grove's future in God's hands. He blessed us over and over! Our missions have not only remained but grown!

Please know, through much prayer, your donations and commitment, we all own Oak Groves's property and buildings! Cemetary included! The United Methodist Conference set a value on our property, along with requirements to pay the minister's salary and benefits, through the end of her proposed assignment June 31, 2023, plus apportionments required through the UMC Conference for 2024. WE PAID IT ALL WITH GOD'S HELP!
